In the event that a DIRECTOR feels that a game must be cancelled due to field conditions caused by rain/weather, the DIRECTOR is to call the officials at least 90 minutes in advance of the game (two hours would be preferred, but we understand the director wanting to wait as long as possible before making the call.) A phone call from the Director to the officials will keep the officials from driving to the location.

In addition, the director must submit the "game change google form" for the game and indicate there was a rain-out so the game can be removed from Horizon. Please indicate in the notes section of the google form that it was a rain-out and the time you called the officials.

ONLY DIRECTORS MAY CANCEL A GAME DUE TO WEATHER.
ONLY DIRECTORS MAY CALL THE OFFICIALS TO CANCEL A GAME DUE TO WEATHER.

There should never be any other phone calls to officials. Other schedule issues such as game changes, etc should be done through the google form and through the Horizon admin. The officials should NEVER be receiving calls from coaches.
